

## **SKENAR or S.C.E.N.A.R**

**S.C.E.N.A.R.** is an acronym for Self-Controlling Energy-Neuro Adaptive Regulation which is both a therapy and the advanced medical treatment device. Russian inventor Alexander Karasev based the original design on the TENS machine concept but while the TENS masks pain, Skenar relieves the cause of the pain by using the principles of acupuncture to harness the body's own healing ability. The Russians continued development of the device because it helped to solve the restrictions of weight and volume of medical equipment for space travel. Russia's version of the FDA approved it in 1986 and it is now widely used in Russian hospitals but it was kept a military secret until the 1990's.

The original development group split into two different companies and the research went forward on two different but similar equipment lines called the 97.4 and the 500/600 Scenar series. In the late 1990's Russian-born doctor Zulia Valeyeva-Frost moved to London and obtained the exclusive rights to manufacture and sell the Scenar in the Americas and parts of the UK and Europe. In 2000, Jerry Tennant, M.D. accepted the position for training Scenar practitioners in America.

The SCENAR device is used by trained therapists to help the body reactivate its self-regulatory mechanism that's been pushed out of balance by accident or disease. Areas of the skin that are connected in some way to stressed or injured tissues or organs will demonstrate abnormal electrical characteristics. The device indicates what the body needs for self-healing and then different signals are used to bring the brain's focus to the area for more rapid healing and pain relief. This self-regulation is achieved by the body's neuropeptides, sometimes called the body's pharmacy, being stimulated into action by the device with proper treatment protocols.

There are several different models on the market today and the SCENAR is certified by the European Common Market's equivalent of the FDA for pain control. In the U.S. the technology is registered with the FDA as a biofeedback device for muscle re-education and relaxation training. Dr. Tennant has several patents pending on his new generation of the technology called the BioModulator. The device is the cornerstone of his comprehensive healing therapy.
